MENTORS MUST HAVE AN HONORABLE DISCHARGE AND SHOW PROOF WITH A DD214. MENTORS MUST ALSO SUBMIT TO A BACKGROUND CHECK Mentors will be expected to participate in observation, training, shadowing, and supervision as part of their entry into the mentoring program. Mentors will also be expected to attend additional trainings and monthly group supervision meetings, as requested by the Veterans Treatment Court Mentor Coordinator. The Veterans Treatment Court program is looking for at least an 18 month commitment from all volunteers prior to entering into the training program.
